## JJTC Welcomes Sarra Moberly

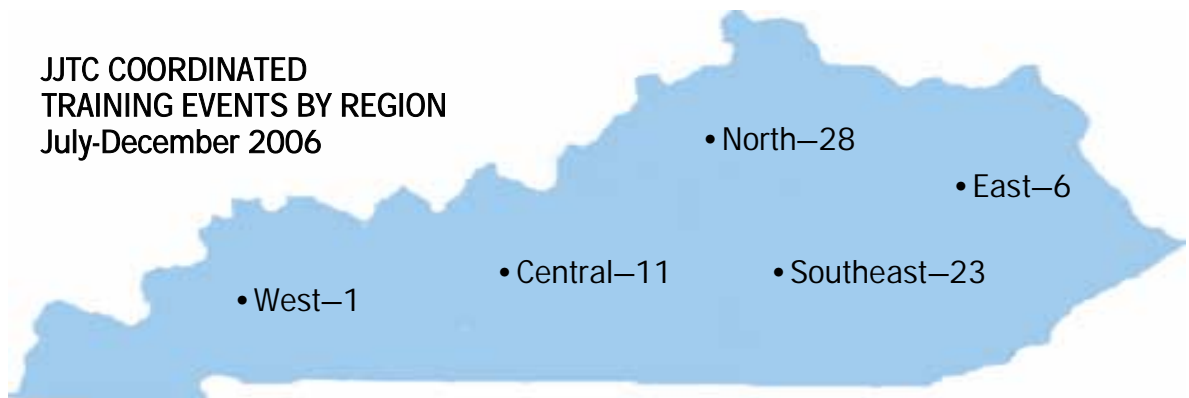

## DJJ Recognizes Academy 54 Graduates

The Department of Juvenile Justice recognized 47 graduates of Academy 54 at the Clarion Hotel and Conference Center in Louisville on December 15, 2006. The graduation speaker was Dr. Rodney Young, Director of DJJ's Division of Mental Health Services.

Academy 54 was held at The Chapel located on the Audubon Youth Development Center's campus in Louisville. This was the first Academy held at this facility since 1998.

Academy 55 graduates included 26 Youth Workers and 21 Community Workers. The youth workers attended the full seven-week academy. The community workers attended weeks one, three and seven.
